2026 SAORRA MULTI CLUB SERIES REGULATIONS

1. EVENT TITLE:

The events will be known as the “**2026 SAORRA MULTI CLUB SERIES**”, the Standing Regulations Off Road (as per the relevant governing body for the event), and will be conducted under and in accordance with any statutory requirements of and these Regulations

2. CARS and CLASSES ELIGIBLE:

ELIGIBILITY/DEFINITION

Vehicles complying with the provisions for off road vehicles and classes refer to:

- **Specific requirements for off road vehicles** (as per the relevant governing body for the event).

3. INVITED CLUBS:

SAORRA CLUBS

Adelaide Buggy Club Inc., Gawler Road Knights Car Club Inc., Millicent Sand Buggy Club Inc., Onkaparinga Ramblers Car Club Inc., Spencer Gulf Off Road Racing Assoc., Summit Racing Team Car Club Inc. and Waikerie Riverland Off Road Assoc.

Organising Clubs may invite other off-road clubs which must be listed as OTHER INVITED CLUBS.

4. COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible for SAORRA Multi Club Series points you must belong to one of the above affiliated SAORRA clubs. You must hold the relevant off road or higher licence issued by the relevant governing body for the event. Competitors must enter each SAORRA event under an affiliated club. If dual club memberships are held competitors will not be eligible for points if entered under a club not affiliated with SAORRA (regulation 3).

There will be four (4) events in the 2026 SAORRA Multi Club Series. These events will take place at venues to be advised by the organising clubs. Refer Regulation 13 for list of SAORRA Multi Club Calendar of Events for 2026 All clubs to comply with the three week event separation rule (3 week spacing between events) starting 2026

5. STARTING ORDER:

All long course events will generally have their starting order determined by Prologue
If no Prologue, cars will be allocated a start position based on previous SAORRA event results

or

As per Supplementary Regulations

In the event of a Prologue

i) Competitors may make only one attempt at a prologue unless in the event of a timing malfunction, or any unforeseen circumstances, the Organiser and or the Clerk of Course reserve the right to give a second run.

ii) Cars that do not finish the prologue will be given a start position at the rear of the field in front of those that do not start the prologue or seeded for safety reasons as per Clerk of Course determination

iii) For events which incorporate a time break e.g., night events) the "position on the road" must be maintained.

Short and Long Course events may start two cars at a time as determined by the Organisers. Short Course events may start more than two cars at a time. In all instances of more than a one car start permission must be granted by the relevant governing body for the event

6 **LATE TIME AND CONTROLS:**

All cars must receive the same late time which also must be set before the event/section starts. There will be no stopping at controls.

7 **COMPASSIONATE TIME ALLOWANCE:**

May only be considered by the Organisers under the following circumstance:

- Stopping during the event to assist another competitor who has had an accident where bodily injury may be involved. Corroborative evidence of the physical assistance in written form must be provided by the crew assisted and/or other witnesses as to the time and circumstance.
- Any time allowance must take into consideration all aspects of the circumstances involved, including the condition of the vehicle of the claimant. Calculated by averaging the times of the other laps of the competitor plus or minus time.

8. **CREWS:**

Navigators are compulsory at all events in vehicles fitted with two seats

9. **SHARE DRIVERS, NAVIGATORS or CO-DRIVERS:**

- **If two or more drivers share a car then points will be shared equally between drivers.**
- **If two or more navigators/co-drivers share a car then points will be shared equally between navigators/co-drivers.**
- **Any Driver / Navigator who is named on the entry form must compete in the event to gain points.**
- **Nomination of points will NOT be allowed and points will be shared between all drivers / navigators listed on the entry form.**

In an emergency where an additional navigator is required during the race, this must be notified to the Event Secretary before that person enters the car. If a listed driver / navigator does not enter the vehicle during the event you are responsible for informing the Event Secretary or Point Scorer prior to the end of that race weekend. Should you not inform the Event Secretary or Point Scorer (If one or more participants did not enter the vehicle) all points will be shared as previously stated.

Event Secretaries must notify the Point Scorer of these situations when they post results as soon as possible to the end of the event

10. **MULTIPLE ENTRIES:**

Any competitor who enters two or more cars at an event, must nominate prior to the start of the event in which car series points will be accumulated. Points scores gained in the other vehicle will be ignored.

11. ENTRY IN MORE THAN ONE CLASS:

Any competitor who throughout the Events enters in more than one class will be awarded OUTRIGHT points at each event, depending on outright position. CLASS points will also be accumulated for the class nominated in at each event. At the end of the year class position and outright will be determined in each class and in total by totalling these points.

12. COMPETITION NUMBERS:

All vehicles must have either a National or State registered number. National numbers are available from the relevant Governing Bodies.

A competitor who has a National number has preference to that number over a State registered car.

14. VEHICLE LOG BOOK/PASS BOOK:

Vehicle Log Books/Pass books are required for all competing vehicles. As issued by the relevant governing body for the event

15. REFLECTIVE NUMBER PLATES:

All vehicles must have a white reflective background to their rear facing number for night sections only. refer to Standard Supplementary Regulations for 2025. It is optional to have this background etc for other numbers on your vehicle.

16. REFUELLING:

Refuelling areas for vehicles will be as designated in Supplementary Regulations. Refuelling out on the track will be at the Clerk of Course's discretion and must be advised in the Supplementary Regulations.

17. NAVIGATION AIDS

No personal GPS Navigation aids are to be active during competition, except for event timing and event safety / car location, unless the overall event is of higher status, where personal GPS is allowed.

If navigation aids are fitted to vehicle at SAORRA Multiclub status events, they must be disabled to Chief Scrutineers satisfaction

Mobile phones are allowed for emergency purposes only.

Mobile phones must not be visible from driver and navigator position during competition

Penalty for not complying with these regulations is exclusion

2026 ARB SAORRA MULTI CLUB SERIES REGULATIONS

18. FINISHER:

To be eligible for SAORRA Series Points the following conditions apply:

Multi Stage Events

For any event which takes place in stages, it should be noted that all laps for each stage must be completed within the late time for that stage.

Short Course

Competitors who "DNF" any heat will be given the "Late Time" allowed per heat. Late time will be applied to all heats where a competitor 'DNFs'

OR

Each and every lap of an off-road short course event is timed and to be classified as a finisher you must complete a minimum of 70% of the total distance

Long Course

To be classified as a finisher in long course events you must complete 75% of the prescribed event laps within the allocated late time

As per Supplementary Regulations

19. POINTS:

SAORRA Multi-club Series Outright winners 1, 2, and 3 will be determined by the highest points overall, calculated by the sum of class and outright points from each event. Class winners are also determined by the same formula as above.

Points shall be allocated to drivers and navigators of the first 10 cars in each Class at each event as follows:

1 st	2 nd	3 rd	4 th	5 th	6 th	7 th	8 th	9 th	10 th

A further allocation will be made to the first 20 cars outright at each event as follows:

A further 5 points will be allocated for starting the event. These points will be in addition to points received for class and outright placings.

To be eligible for these points you must have at least started the prologue, these starting points will be allocated to the crew combination as per series regulation 9.

2026 ARB SAORRA MULTI CLUB SERIES REGULATIONS

SAORRA SERIES TROPHIES:

To be eligible for SAORRA Series Trophies:

- You must have entered in at least two (2) SAORRA Series events and finished one (1).

SAORRA Series Trophies will be awarded as follows:

1st, 2nd, 3rd Outright Driver & Navigator

1st, 2nd & 3rd in Class for Driver and Navigator depending on number of entries in each class over the SAORRA Multi Club Series events

6 or more entries: 1st, 2nd, 3rd

1 to 5 entries: 1st and 2nd

3 or less: 1st only

or

At the SAORRA Committee's discretion

20. SAFETY

- a. For all night events, competitors will be required to wear 2 x 50mm reflective arm bands.
- b. Mufflers are to be fitted to all vehicles. Turbo chargers are not considered to be a muffler. Maximum noise emission permitted is 95dba. **NO MUFFLER, NO START**
- c. At least one clear white forward-facing running light to be operating at all times during competition

21. PENALTIES

Causing direct disadvantage to another competitor. i.e.: failing to allow a faster competitor to pass	1 st offence	Pull in to pits for 'Stop/Go' Penalty
	2 nd offence	Pull in to pits for 'Stop/Go' Penalty plus 2-minute time penalty
	3 rd offence	Exclusion from the event

Plus, any further penalties that may be imposed by the Clerk of Course and or Stewards of the meeting.

Summit Racing Team Club Inc
Waikerie Riverland Off Road Association.

The SAORRA Outright Driver & Navigator of the year will be determined by outright and class points calculated as per the formula listed in the "SAORRA MultiClub Series Regulations for 2026"

Points will only be allocated from the SAORRA 2026 Calendared Events as per the "SAORRA MultiClub Series Regulations for 2026"

Awards to be presented are:

SAORRA 1st Outright Driver of the Year / SAORRA 1st Outright Navigator of the Year
SAORRA 2nd Outright Driver of the Year / SAORRA 2nd Outright Navigator of the Year
SAORRA 3rd Outright Driver of the Year / SAORRA 3rd Outright Navigator of the Year

Class Awards (all classes)

1st in Class Driver / 1st in Class Navigator

2nd in Class Driver / 2nd in Class Navigator

3rd in Class Driver / 3rd in Class Navigator
